

BYLAW NUMBER 69-6
OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PRINCE

Being a bylaw to legalize the holding of a nomination meeting and Election in and for the Township of Prince to be held in 1969 for the years 1970 and 1971

The Municipal Council of the Township of Prince, in the District of Algoma enacts as follows:

That a nomination meeting for the purpose of nominating a Reeve and Council Members for the said Township for the years 1970 and 1971 shall be held in the Community Hall, R. R. #1, Gros Cap, Prince, on the 19th day of November, 1969 at the hour of 8:00 ^{1/2} o'clock in the afternoon. If more candidates are proposed for any particular office than required to be elected, an election will be held on Monday, December 1, 1969. The Poll will be held at the Community Hall, Gros Cap, R. R. #1, Prince.
