

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PRINCE

BY-LAW NO. 70-9

TRAFFIC: A by-law to authorize the erection of a stop sign at the northeast corner of the intersection of Base Line Road and Walls Road.

THE COUNCIL of The Corporation of the Township of Prince pursuant to paragraph 105 of subsection 1 of section 379 of The Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1960, chapter 249 and amendments thereto ENACTS as follows:

1. Definitions

In this by-law

- (a) "highway" includes a common and public highway, street, avenue, parkway, driveway, square, place, bridge, viaduct or trestle, designed and intended for, or used by, the general public for the passage of vehicles;
- (b) "intersection" means the area embraced within the prolongation or connection of the lateral curb lines or, if none, then of the lateral boundary lines of two or more highways that join one another at an angle, whether or not one highway crosses the other;
- (c) "Minister" means the Minister of Transport;
- (d) "official sign" means a sign approved by the Department of Transport

2. Stop sign at the intersection of Base Line Road and Walls Road

The Corporation shall erect a stop sign at the intersection of Base Line Road and Walls Road facing traffic proceeding in an ~~west~~ westerly direction on the Base Line Road.

3. Enforcement

This by-law shall be enforced by the Ontario Provincial Police.

4. Penalty

Any person who contravenes the provisions of this by-law is subject to the penalty provided therefor in The Highway Traffic Act.

5. By-law subject to The Highway Traffic Act

The provisions of this by-law are subject to the provisions of The Highway Traffic Act and amendments thereto.

6. Department of Transport approval

This by-law shall not become effective until approved by the Department of Transport for Ontario nor shall any particular provision thereof become effective until the sign or signs, if any, applicable to such particular provision has or have been erected and is or are on display.
