

BYLAW NUMBER 71-5

OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PRINCE

Being a bylaw to legalize the holding of a nomination meeting and Election in and for the Township of Prince to be held in 1971 for the years 1972 and 1973

The Municipal Council of the Township of Prince, in the District of Algoma enacts as follows:

That a nomination meeting for the purpose of nominating a Reeve and Council Members for the said Township for the years 1972 and 1973 shall be held in the Community Hall, R. R. #1, Gros Cap, Prince, on the 25th day of November, 1971 at the hour of 8:00 o'clock to 9:00 o'clock in the afternoon. If more candidates are proposed for any particular office than required to be elected, an election will be held on Monday, December 6, 1971. The Poll will be held at the Community Hall, Gros Cap, R. R. #1, Prince.
