

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PRINCE

BY-LAW NUMBER 75-3

Being a bylaw to appoint a Clerk-Treasurer and Tax Collector for the Township of Prince

WHEREAS Section 352 (63) of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1970, Chapter 284 authorizes Council of all municipalities enter alia to pass by-laws appointing such officers and servants as may be necessary for the purpose of the Corporation, or for carrying into effect the provisions of any act of the Legislature or by-law of the Council for fixing their remuneration and prescribing their duties, and the security to be given for the performance thereof; and

WHEREAS by resolution number 17 dated the 8th day of February, 1972, Mrs. Lucy Konkin was appointed as Clerk-Treasurer and Tax Collector of the Corporation of the Township of Prince

THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Prince ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the appointments of Mrs. Lucy Konkin as Clerk-Treasurer and Tax Collector by resolution number 17, passed on the 8th day of February, 1972 be and it is hereby confirmed.
2. That the said Mrs. Lucy Konkin be appointed and engaged to hold the office of Clerk-Treasurer and Tax Collector as of the 8th day of February, 1972 on a yearly basis until terminated.
3. That the said Mrs. Lucy Konkin shall be paid a salary of \$150 per month and 5% of all taxes collected including grants under the tax stabilization Act and all other Federal and Provincial Grants paid subject to such further adjustments of her salary as Council may from time to time see fit.
4. This by-law shall not be repealed or amended without due cause and not until such time as proper hearings are held as provided by the Municipal Act, if required.

Read a first, second and third time and finally passed in Open Council this 8th day of April, 1975.
