

TOWNSHIP OF PRINCE

BYLAW NO. 75-6

A by-law to establish a Municipal Recreation Committee as authorized by regulations issued under the Ministry of Culture and Recreation Act

1. There is hereby established for the Township of Prince a RECREATION COMMITTEE which shall be responsible for the development of a program of RECREATION for the inhabitants of the Township of Prince in accordance with regulations issued under the Ministry of Culture and Recreation Act.
2. The said committee shall be known as the Township of Prince Recreation Committee.
3. The Township of Prince Recreation Committee shall be appointed by the Municipal Council of the Township of Prince and, shall consist of ten members, two of whom shall be members of the Municipal Council and eight of whom shall be residents of the municipality.
4. The appointments to the Township of Prince Recreation Committee shall be made annually at the first meeting of the Municipal Council of the Township of Prince or as soon thereafter as is expedient. The members shall hold office during the pleasure of the Municipal Council of the Township of Prince.
5. DUTIES OF THE RECREATION COMMITTEE
 - (a) The Committee shall conduct or encourage and assist the programs of recreation which will meet the needs and interests of the inhabitants of the Township of Prince. Such programs shall include the social, cultural, and physical aspects of recreation as applied to each group, both male and female.
 - (b) The Committee shall assist in the coordination of community recreation activities.
 - (c) The Committee shall assist, encourage and provide advisory services on request to all groups, organizations, or persons carrying on recreation activities in the Township of Prince.
 - (d) The Committee shall at all times keep the inhabitants of the Township of Prince aware of the recreation opportunities which are available, and shall continually interpret to the public the total community program of recreation.
 - (e) The Committee shall have the power to adopt rules and regulations pertaining to the proper conduct of the community program of recreation, and shall be responsible for the policy and administration of the community program of recreation conducted directly by the Committee.
 - (f) The Committee may recommend to the Municipal Council of the Township of Prince the appointment of a Director of Recreation.
 - (g) The Committee may recommend the appointment of recreation workers, either part-time or full-time, and shall be responsible for assigning the duties and responsibilities of such employees. Where a Director of Recreation is employed, such appointments should be subject to the recommendation of the Director.
 - (h) the Committee is empowered to work jointly with other Municipal departments to establish and conduct a supervised system of recreation.

- (i) As directed from time to time by the Municipal Council of the Township of Prince, the Committee is empowered to operate, improve, and maintain property for parks, playgrounds, recreation centres, and other recreation facilities.
- (j) The Committee may solicit or receive any gifts or bequests of money or services or any donations to be applied, principal or income, for either the temporary or permanent use of facilities, equipment, program or other recreational purposes.
- (k) Annually, the Committee shall submit and interpret to the Municipal Council of the Township of Prince a budget for its approval and shall make to the Municipal Council full and complete reports as required.
- (l) In carrying out the provisions of the by-law, the Committee shall at all times be the agent of the Municipal Council of the Township of Prince and while acting bonafide within the limits of the authority of this by-law, neither the Committee nor any member thereof shall incur any liability by reasons of anything done or left undone by the Committee provided however, that nothing in this paragraph shall empower the Committee to incur any debt, liability or obligation for which the Municipal Council of the Township of Prince shall become liable, without having previously obtained the written consent of the Municipal Council.

AMENDMENT TO BY-LAW 75-6

The Township of Prince Recreation Committee shall be appointed by the Municipal Council of the Township of Prince and, shall consist of a minimum of three members, ~~two of whom shall be members of the Municipal Council and a maximum of twelve~~ and a maximum of twelve members, two of whom shall be members of the Municipal Council and the remainder shall be residents of the municipality.
