

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PRINCE

BY-LAW NO. 76-5

A by-law to acquire lands for the purpose of opening and making highways.

WHEREAS section 465(1) of The Municipal Act provides that "The council of a township in unorganized territory surveyed without highways, may pass by-laws for opening and making highways where necessary and the provisions of this Act as to compensation for lands taken or injuriously affected by the exercise of the powers conferred by this section do not apply."

AND WHEREAS it is desirable for the Township to pass this by-law in order to open and make certain highways with respect to the lands hereinafter described, which lands are situate within the Township of Prince, District of Algoma, Province of Ontario.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED THAT the Corporation of the Township of Prince hereby ENACTS as follows:

1. LANDS ACQUIRED

In accordance with the provisions of section 465(1) of The Municipal Act, the lands described as Part 1 on Plan LR 2539 in the Northeast quarter of Section 1 in the Township of Prince are hereby acquired by the Corporation of the Township of Prince for the purpose of opening and making highways.

2. EXECUTION OF DOCUMENTS

The Reeve and the Clerk are hereby authorized for and in the name of the Corporation to execute and to affix the seal of the Corporation to all documents required to give effect to this by-law.

3. EFFECTIVE DATE

This by-law takes effect on the day of its final passing.
