

BYLAW NO. 77-2

A Bylaw to Appoint a Road Superintendent
in the Township of Prince
in the District of Algoma

WHEREAS it is desirable that the laying out and supervision of all work and expenditure upon improvement and maintenance of roads within the exclusive jurisdiction of this Council should be under the supervision of a Road Superintendent, acting under its direction.

AND WHEREAS it is the desire of this Council to take advantage of The Public Transportation and Highway Improvement Act and to receive the Government grant as provided in the said Act.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the Council of the municipal corporation of the said township and it is hereby enacted.

1. That J. Zgraja, R. R. #1, Prince, Sault Ste. Marie, Ont. is appointed Road Superintendent in the said township to act as aforesaid in accordance with the provisions of the said Act from the 9th day of February, 1977 and during the pleasure of the said Council.
2. THAT it shall be the duty of the superintendent to lay out and supervise all work and expenditure on roads within the exclusive jurisdiction of this Township Council in accordance with the provisions of the Public Transportation and Highway Improvement Act.
3. THAT one certified copy of this by-law be forwarded by the clerk without delay to the district office of the Municipal Roads Branch, Ministry of Transportation and Communications.
