

BY-LAW NO. 77-5

OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF THE TOWNSHIP

Being a by-law to amend By-
No. 70-6 prohibiting the use of
trailers for living, sleeping or
eating accommodations within the
Municipality of the Township of
Prince

THE COUNCIL for the Municipality of the Township of Prince enacts as follows: add on the following words to Paragraph 1 of By-law 70-6: "Which duration can be extended by application to and approval by the Council of the Municipality of the Township of Prince." so that such Paragraph 1 now reads:

"1. No person shall use, and no owner or lessee of any trailer, shall permit the use of any trailer for the living, sleeping or eating accommodations of persons within the Municipality of the Township of Prince, for more than sixty (60) days in any period of ten (10) consecutive months which duration can be extended by application to and approval by the Council of the Municipality of the Township of Prince."

READ a first, second and third time, and finally passed in open council, this 12th day of July, 1977.
