

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PRINCE

BY-LAW NO. 77-6

being a By-Law to regulate traffic in the aforesaid Township.

THE COUNCIL of The Corporation of the Township of Prince, pursuant to paragraph 107 of subsection 1 of Section 354 of The Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1970, Chapter 284 and amendments thereto, ENACTS as follows:

1. The Corporation shall erect a stop sign at the intersection set out in column 1 herein of this by-law facing traffic proceeding in the direction set out in column 2 herein on the street or part of street set out in column 3 herein.

2.	Column 1 <u>Intersection</u>	Column 2 <u>Direction of Traffic</u>	Column 3 <u>Stop Sign</u>
	Base Line and Gagnon Road	Southerly	Gagnon Road

3. Penalty

Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this By-Law is liable upon summary conviction therefor to a penalty of not less than Ten Dollars and not more than Fifty Dollars, exclusive of costs.

4. Effective Date

This By-Law shall not become effective, nor shall any particular provision herein become effective until the sign or signs, if any, applicable to such particular provision has or have been erected and is or are on display.
