BYLAW NO. 82-14

Zoning Bylaw to Amend Township of Prince Zoning By-law No. 77-7

Concerning the Text

The Council of the Corporation of the Township of Prince, pursuant to Section 39 of The Planning Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 379 and amendments thereto ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Section 5 General Provisions for All Zones, paragraph IX, Special Uses Permitted is amended by adding the following sub sections:

- .5 The lands known as part of the broken northwest 1/4 of Section 31 in the Township of Prince, located at the end of the Second Line West (Highway #550), and commonly known as the "island" at the Gros Cap turn-around may be used for a water pumping station by the Public Utilities Commission.
- .6 That the part of the northeast 1/4 of Section 32, in the Township of Prince, located approximately 99.7 m north and to the rear of the property known as 32 Marshall Drive, may be used for a water pump control tank by the Public Utilities Commission.

By-law 77-7 continues to apply

The provisions of By-law 77-7 as amended hereby, continues to apply to the lands affected by this By-law except insofar as they are inconsistent with this By-law or higher or more restrictive or onerous requirements are imposed hereby.

Certificate of Conformity

This is hereby certified that this By-law No. 82-14 is in conformity with the Sault Ste. Marie Planning Area Official Plan authorized and enforced on the day of passing of this By-law as amended by Official Plan Amendment No. 182. Clauses f, g, h, i, j and o of Rule 1 of the Revised Rules and Procedures of the Ontario Municipal Board do not apply.

Ontario Municipal Board Approval

No part of this By-law comes into force without the approval of the Ontario Municipal Board, but, subject to such approval, this By-law takes effect from the date of the passing thereof.
