

CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PRINCE

BY-LAW NO. 85-6

being a by-law to provide for the reimbursement of expenses to members of Council and Officers and servants of the municipality.

WHEREAS Section 239 of The Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1980 authorizes a municipality to pass a by-law determining the conditions under which expenses incurred by members of council and officers and servants of the municipality may be reimbursed;

THEREFORE be it enacted that

1. Council members and officers and servants of the municipality designated by council resolution to attend conventions; seminars; and other meetings held outside of the municipal boundaries may be reimbursed for expenditures incurred in attending these meetings.

2. Expenses for the purposes of Section 1 shall include, but not be necessarily limited to the following.

- (a) hotel and/or accommodation charges
- (b) meals
- (c) registration fees
- (d) travel expenses
- (e) loss in wages

All claims shall be supported by receipts except for meals which on a daily basis shall not exceed \$25.00 per day. Travel should be by the cheapest method available and where private vehicles are used the rate of reimbursement shall be 25¢ per km.

3. Expenses as set out in Clause 2 shall, as appropriate also apply to council members when they attend properly constituted council meetings and such other meetings within the boundaries of the municipality as approved by council resolution for the purposes of using this by-law.

4. This by-law shall come into force upon its passing.
