

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PRINCE

BY-LAW NO. 86-11

WHEREAS it has been made to appear that many persons have created a nuisance by depositing and leaving upon the highways of the Municipal Township of Prince, dirt, filth, glass, handbills, paper, tin cans and other rubbish and refuse;

AND WHEREAS by the Municipal Act of the Province of Ontario, R.S.O 1980, Ch. 302, Section 210, Subsection 76, authority is granted to Councils of Municipalities to pass by-laws prohibiting the throwing, placing or depositing on any highway or bridge all dirt, filth, glass, handbills, paper or other rubbish or refuse or the carcass of any animal.

NOW THEREFORE the Township of Prince ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. No person shall throw, place or deposit on private property or on property of the municipality of the Township of Prince, any dirt, filth, glass, vehicle bodies, paper or other rubbish, refuse or the carcass of any animal.
2. Every person who contravenes the terms of this by-law shall be guilty of an offence and shall, upon conviction thereof before a Police Magistrate or Justice of the Peace, be liable to a penalty not exceeding \$300.00 for such offence and every such penalty shall be recoverable under the Provincial Offences Act, R.S.O. 1980 as amended.
3. By-law 377 is hereby repealed.
4. This By-law shall take effect and come into effect on the passing thereof.
