

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PRINCE

BY-LAW NO. 86-17

WHEREAS it has been made to appear that many persons have created a nuisance by depositing and leaving upon private ^{public} ~~or~~ property and property of the Municipal Township of Prince, refuse and debris;

AND WHEREAS by the Municipal Act of the Province of Ontario, R.S.O. 1980, Ch. 302, Section 210, Subsection 76, authority is granted to Councils of Municipalities to pass by-laws prohibiting the throwing, placing or depositing of refuse or debris on private property or on property of the municipality without authority from the owner or occupant of such property;

NOW THEREFORE the Township of Prince ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. No person shall throw, place or deposit on private ^{public property} property, or on property of the municipality of the Township of Prince or any local board thereof, any refuse or debris without authority from the owner or occupant of such property.
2. Every person who contravenes the terms of this by-law shall be guilty of an offence and shall, upon conviction thereof before a Police Magistrate or Justice of the Peace, be liable to a penalty not exceeding \$300.00 for such offence and every such penalty shall be recoverable under the Provincial Offences Act, R.S.O. 1980 as amended.
3. By-law #86-11 is hereby repealed.
4. This By-law shall take effect and come into effect on the passing thereof.
