

BY-LAW 87-1

CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PRINCE

**ESTABLISHMENT OF LOCAL PUBLIC LIBRARY**


**WHEREAS** Section 3 of the Public Libraries Act, 1984, Chapter 57, Statutes of Ontario, 1984, provides that the Council of a Municipality may by by-law establish a public library.

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the Municipality of the Township of Prince **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. That a public library be established under Part 1 of the Public Libraries Act, 1984, c. 57, S.O. 1984 for the Municipality of the Township of Prince effective January 1st, 1987.
2. That the Prince Township Public Library Board shall be composed of five (5) members appointed by the Council.
3. That the Library Board shall employ a librarian as Chief Executive Officer who shall have general supervision over and direction of the operations of the public library and its staff, shall attend all board meetings and shall have the other powers and duties that the board assigns to him or her from time to time.
4. That the Council shall in each year appropriate and pay to the Board the amount of the estimates of the board that is approved by the Council for the establishment, operation, and maintenance of a comprehensive and efficient public library service that reflects the municipality's unique needs.
5. That the Library Board has exclusive control of the disbursement of the finances of the library.
6. That the property and the income, revenues, issues and profits of all property of the Library Board shall be applied solely to the establishment, operation and maintenance of a public library service.
7. In the event of a conflict between any provision of this By-law and any provision of the Public Libraries Act, 1984, the provision of the Act prevails.

**READ** a first, second and third time, and finally passed this 14th day of April, 1987, and the Corporation Seal attached.
