

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PRINCE

BY-LAW NO. 89-1

LICENSING: A by-law to provide for the licensing of lotteries.

THE COUNCIL of The Corporation of the Township of Prince, ENACTS as follows:

1. LOTTERY LICENSING OFFICER APPOINTED

The Administrator is hereby appointed Lottery Licensing Officer for the Township of Prince.

2. TENURE - DUTIES

The said Administrator shall hold office during the pleasure of the Council and shall exercise all the authority, powers and rights and shall perform all the duties and obligations which by Statute or by-laws are or may be conferred or imposed upon the Lottery Licensing Officer and other duties that may be imposed by Council.

3. DELEGATION

Where any responsibility, duty, power or authority is conferred by this by-law on an Administrator of Licences, such person may delegate all or part thereof to any employee of the Corporation, or a local board thereof, who acts under his direction, and, while so acting, such person shall stand in the place and stead of such Administrator of Licenses.

4. FEES

No license shall be issued under this by-law for any lottery in the Township of Prince unless there is first paid to the Corporation a fee or fees in accordance with Schedule "B" hereto.

5. PROVINCIAL REGULATIONS

All applications for licenses for lotteries shall be received, considered and decided in accordance with Order-in-Council 274/70 and the conditions prescribed from time to time by the Minister of Consumer and Commercial Relations.

6. PROVINCIAL LICENSES

Any person desiring a license to conduct a lottery which license can only be issued by the Ministry of Consumer and Commercial Relations shall file his application for such license together with the prescribed fee with the Lottery Licensing Officer who shall:

- (1) Report on the matter to the Township Council with his recommendation as to whether or not the application shall be recommended.
- (2) Forward the application, the prescribed fee and the resolution of the Township Council that recommends for or against the application to the Ministry of Consumer and Commercial Relations.

7. ISSUE OF LICENSES

The Lottery Licensing Officer is authorized to issue a license under this By-law at any time when a satisfactory application for such license has been filed with him. Where in his opinion there is reason to believe that the applicant is not qualified to conduct the lottery in question, or in his opinion it is not in the public interest to issue such license, he may refuse the application and refer the matter to the Council for decision. Any license issued under this by-law shall be subject to the conditions set forth on Schedule "A" hereto.

8. ADMINISTRATION

This by-law shall be administered by the Lottery Licensing Officer in cooperation with the By-law Enforcement Officer.

9. SCHEDULE "A"

Schedule "A" forms a part of this by-law.

10. EFFECTIVE DATE

This by-law takes effect on the day of its final passing.

SCHEDULE "A"

To By-Law 89-1

Schedule of Fees to be Charged  
for Lottery Licenses.

For any lottery license, the fees to be paid are as follows:

1. Where the value of all prizes to be awarded is \$100.00 or less . . . . . no charge
2. Where the value of all prizes to be awarded exceeds \$100.00 but does not exceed \$250.00 . . . . . \$5.00
3. Where the value of all prizes is \$250 but does not exceed \$5,000.00 . . . . . Two percent (2%) of the value of all prizes to be awarded.
