

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PRINCE

BY-LAW NO. 89-8

Being a by-law concerning the sole use of English as the official language in carrying out the programs and work of the Corporation of the Township of Prince.

WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Prince recognizes that the Township is composed of many different ethnic groups, languages and cultures;

AND WHEREAS the Township has always shown respect for each of these cultures by providing preferential treatment for none;

AND WHEREAS the Township has had one common working language (which is English) for all of its services and oral and written communications;

AND WHEREAS the preferred common language of business, commerce, trade, science and normal everyday activities is English;

NOW THEREFORE in the interests of maintaining goodwill, harmony and responsible fiscal management the municipal council of the Corporation of the Township of Prince ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT the English language be used as the official language of the Corporation in carryout out the programs and the work of the Corporation including:

- (a) the provision of all services to and communication with the public and all levels of government by all the staff of the departments and agencies of the Corporation;
- (b) the provision of public signs and any other form of public information material;
- (c) the reply to any correspondence received regardless of the language of original enquiry; and
- (d) the recruitment and staffing of personnel for the Corporation.

2. THAT this by-law shall come into force and take effect immediately upon the final passing thereof.
