

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PRINCE

BY-LAW #90-3

A By-law to Prohibit Parking

THE COUNCIL of the Corporation of the Township of Prince pursuant to paragraph 117 of Section 210 of The Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1980, chapter 302 and amendments thereto,

ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. DEFINITIONS

In this By-law:

- (1) "Street" includes a highway and roadway and means the entire width between the boundary lines of the street or highway;
- (2) "Park" or "Parking" means the standing of a vehicle, whether occupied or not, except when standing temporarily for the purpose of and while actually engaged in loading or unloading of merchandise or passengers;
- (3) "Vehicle" includes a motor vehicle, trailer, traction engine, farm tractor, road-building machine and any vehicle drawn, propelled or driven by any kind of power, including muscular power.

2. PARKING REGULATIONS

When properly worded signs have been erected and are on display, no person shall at any time, park a vehicle on any street at the side and between the limits set out respectively in columns 1, 2 and 3 of "Schedule A" to this by-law during the times or days set out in column 4 of the said "Schedule A".

3. VEHICLES SUBJECT TO REMOVAL WHEN ILLEGALLY PARKED

In addition to any other penalties provided by this by-law, upon discovery of any vehicle parked on any street in contravention of the provisions of this by-law, a By-law Enforcement Officer may cause such vehicle to be moved or taken to and placed or stored in a suitable place and all costs and charges for the removing, care and storage thereof, if any, are a lien upon the vehicle being released and may be enforced in the manner provided by section 48 of The Mechanics Lien Act.

4. ENFORCEMENT

This by-law shall be enforced by the By-law Enforcement Officer who shall have the authority to enforce the parking provisions of this By-law.

5. PENALTY

(1) Interpretation

Where a penalty is provided in this by-law for a first or subsequent offence, the words "first" or "subsequent" relate only to offences committed in any twelve month period.

(2) Subject to Summary Convictions Act

Any fine imposed or offence created by this by-law is subject to the provisions of the Summary Convictions Act.


(3) Penalty

Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this By-law is liable upon conviction therefor for a first offence to a fine of not less than \$15.00 and not more than \$1,000.00 and for any subsequent offence to a fine of not less than \$20.00 and not more than \$1,000.00 exclusive of costs.
