

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PRINCE

BY-LAW 91- 16

STREETS: A By-law to amend a by-law to provide for the numbering of lots and buildings on streets within the Township of Prince

THE COUNCIL of the Corporation of the Township of Prince pursuant to subsection 106 and 107 of section 210 of The Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1980, chapter 302, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Section 7 of By-law 76-4 is hereby repealed and the following substituted therefor:

7. DUTY OF THE OWNER TO DISPLAY NUMBER

A person, being the owner of a building that has been assigned a street number under By-law 76-4 and amendments thereto, shall display the allocated number at the street fronting the property. Such number shall be no less than 7.5 centimetres or 3 inches in height and shall be clearly visible by traffic from any direction.


2. Section 8 of By-law 76-4 is hereby repealed.

3. That all other provisions of By-law 76-4 not inconsistent with the provisions of this by-law shall continue to apply.

4. This by-law takes effect on the day of its final passing.
