

BY-LAW NO. 91 - 17

Being a by-law to provide for the participation of the Township of Prince Volunteer Fire Department in District Emergency Fire Service Plan and Program


WHEREAS Paragraph 25 of Section 210, Chapter 302 of The Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1980, authorizes the councils of local municipalities to adopt and participate in an emergency fire service plan and program.


NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Prince ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT the Township of Prince Volunteer Fire Department be authorized to leave the limits of the municipality or fire area, at the discretion of the Chief or his/her designee and under the direction of the Algoma District Fire Coordinator, to respond to calls for assistance from other municipal fire departments authorized to participate in the Algoma District Emergency Fire Service Plan and Program or any other Regional, District or County Emergency Fire Service Plan and Program on a reciprocal basis.

2. In case the provisions of this by-law conflict with the provisions of any other by-law, the provisions of this by-law shall prevail.

READ a first, second and third time and finally passed this 8th day of October, 1991.
