

CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PRINCE

BY-LAW NO. 91-20

ZONING: A By-law to enact an Interim Control  
By-law concerning accessory buildings

**WHEREAS** Section 37 of the Planning Act, 1983 provides that a local municipality may pass a by-law prohibiting the use of land, buildings or structures within the municipality or within the defined area or areas thereof for, or except for, such purposes as are set out in the by-law; and

**WHEREAS** Council has by resolution dated November 5, 1991 directed that a review or study be undertaken in respect of the Rural Residential (R.R.) zone provision for accessory buildings;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Prince, pursuant to Section 37 of the Planning Act, 1983 and amendments thereto, ENACTS as follows:

1. PURPOSE

Pursuant to section 37 of the Planning Act, no person shall construct an accessory building in excess of 60 sq. metres (640 square feet) and 4 metres (13 feet) in height in the Rural Residential (R.R.) zone.

2. EXPIRATION

This by-law shall expire one year from the date of passing thereof.

3. EFFECTIVE DATE

This by-law shall take effect from the date of its final passing. Read THREE TIMES and PASSED in open Council this 12th day of December, 1991.
