

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PRINCE

BY-LAW NO. 94-7

STREET CLOSING: (s. 2.2.) a by-law to stop up, close and authorize the sale of part of Hill Road as set out on Plan M-164

WHEREAS the street or part of a street more particularly hereinafter described has been established as a public street and assumed for public use

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Prince pursuant to the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, chapter M. 45 and amendments thereto ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. STREET CLOSED

The street or part of a street more particularly described in Schedule "A" to this by-law, having been assumed by the Corporation for public use, is hereby stopped up and closed.

2. SALE TO ABUTTING OWNERS

The said street shall be offered to the owners of lands abutting thereon. In default of acceptance thereof within thirty days of such offer being made to him by prepaid first class mail, the said street shall be offered to the persons owning land opposite the said street or part of the street.

3. EXPENSES

For any such conveyance the abutting owners will pay the cost of surveys and legal fees.

4. EXECUTION OF DOCUMENTS

The Reeve and the Clerk are hereby authorized for and in the name of the Corporation to execute and to affix the seal of the Corporation to all documents required to give effect to this by-law.


