BY-LAW 99-10

STREET CLOSING: a by-law to stop up, close and authorize the sale of parts of Prince Lake Road in the Delmar Subdivision, Plan M-142, and part of Prince Lake Road in the Prince Lake Subdivision, Plan M-253

WHEREAS the street or parts of a street more particularly hereinafter described have been established as a public street and assumed for public use by by-law 99-9

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township if Prince pursuant to the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter M.45, and amendments thereto, ENACTS as follows:

1. STREET CLOSED

The street or part of a street more particularly described in Schedule "A" to this by-law, having been assumed by the Corporation for public use, is hereby stopped up and closed.

2. TRANSFER TO ABUTTING OWNERS

The said street shall be offered to the owners of lands abutting thereon.

3. **EXCHANGE OF PROPERTY**

In exchange for any such conveyances, the abutting owners will convey to the municipality that portion, if any, of their property now occupied by the actual roadway free of any encroachment(s). The municipality will assume the cost of registration of any conveyances to the municipality, while it will be the responsibility of the property owner to register any conveyance by the municipality to him/her/them.

4. EXECUTION OF DOCUMENTS

The Reeve and the Clerk are hereby authorized for and in the name of the Corporation to execute and to affix the seal of the Corporation to all documents required to give effect to this by-law.
