

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PRINCE

BY-LAW 99-9

STREETS: A by-law to establish as a street and assume for public use parts of Prince Lake Road in the Delmar Subdivision, Plan M-142, and part of Prince Lake Road in the Prince Lake Subdivision, Plan M-253


THE COUNCIL of the Corporation of the Township of Prince, pursuant to the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, chapter M.45 and amendments thereto ENACTS as follows:


1. **STREET ESTABLISHED AND ASSUMED**
The street or part of the street more particularly described in Schedule "A" to this by-law is hereby established as a public street and is hereby assumed for public use.
