CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PRINCE BY-LAW 2000-12

ZONING - A by-law to amend the Township of Prince Zoning By-law 77-7 with respect to property known municipally as 30 Heywood Road and 42 Heywood Road

THE COUNCIL of the Corporation of the Township of Prince, pursuant to sections 34 of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, and amendments thereto, ENACTS the following:

1. PARTS OF THE NORTH EAST QUARTER OF THE SOUTH WEST QUARTER OF SECTION 33, IN THE TOWNSHIP OF PRINCE, (30 HEYWOOD ROAD & 42 HEYWOOD ROAD) CHANGED FROM R.R. (RURAL RESIDENTIAL) TO R.R.-S. (RURAL RESIDENTIAL WITH A SPECIAL EXCEPTION)

The zone designation on the lands described in Section 2 of the By-law, which lands are shown on Schedule "A" to by-law 77-7 and also outlined and marked "subject property" on the map attached as Schedule "A" to this by-law is changed from R.R. (Rural Residential) to R.R.-S. (Rural Residential with a Special Exception).

2. SCHEDULE "A"

Schedule "A" hereto forms part of this by-law.

3. BY-LAW 77-7 SPECIAL EXCEPTION

Notwithstanding the provisions of By-law 77-7, as amended, the properties as outlined on Schedule "A" will be deemed to be subject to the requirements of Section 7, I - Rural Residential, 4 - Exceptions for Residential Use as follows:

Lot Area Lot Frontage Lot Coverage

Yard Requirements

Front Yard Side Yard Rear Yard Minimum 1390 square metres

Administrator

Minimum 24 metres Maximum 25%

Minimum 15 metres Minimum 3 metres Minimum 10 metres

4. BY-LAW 77-7 CONTINUES TO APPLY

The provisions of By-law 77-7 as amended hereby, continue to apply to the lands affected by this by-law except insofar as they are inconsistent with this by-law or higher or more restrictive or onerous requirements are imposed hereby.
