THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PRINCE

BY-LAW NO. 2001-12

A by-law to prohibit the throwing, placing or depositing of refuse or debris on private property or on property of the municipality or any local board thereof without authority from the owner or occupant of such property

WHEREAS pursuant to paragraph 82 of Section 210 of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.302 as amended, by-laws may be passed by the Council for prohibiting the throwing, placing or depositing of refuse or debris on private property or on property of the municipality of any local board thereof without authority from the owner or occupant of such property;

NOW THEREFORE the Council for the Corporation of the Township of Prince ENACTS as follows:

Throwing of Refuse and Debris

- 1. (1) No person shall throw, place or deposit refuse, debris or domestic waste upon private property in the Township of Prince without the consent of the owner of the property.
 - (2) No person shall throw, place or deposit refuse, debris or domestic waste on Township property without the written consent of the Corporation.

Signage

2. The presence of a "No Dumping" sign shall be deemed to indicate a lack of consent on the part of the owner.

Penalty

3. Every person who contravenes any of the provisions of this by-law is guilty of an offence, and liable upon conviction, to a penalty of not more than Five Thousand (\$5,000.00) exclusive of costs
