

# THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PRINCE

## BY-LAW #2004-3

A by-law to establish fees for certain waste management services

WHEREAS notice of this by-law coming before Council was given in the January 2004 municipal newsletter

THE Council of the Corporation of the Township of Prince, pursuant to section 391 of the Municipal Act, 2001, and amendments thereto and to Section 4 of Ontario Regulation 244/02 ENACTS as follows:

### 1. **CURBSIDE LIMITS**

- a. Effective May 01, 2004, a maximum of three (3) untagged garbage bags or three (3) untagged containers per household per week shall be collected at curbside.
- b. Effective January 01, 2005, a maximum number of two (2) untagged garbage bags or two (2) untagged containers per household per week shall be collected at curbside.

### 2. **TAGS FOR EXCESS**

- a. Effective May 01, 2004, any bags or containers in excess of the limits as set out in this by-law must bear a municipal identification tag.
- b. Municipal identification tags will be available from 01 May 2004 at a fee of \$2.00 per tag.
- c. Any bags or containers in excess of the limits as set out in this by-law without the municipal identification tag will not be collected.


### 3. **EFFECTIVE DATE**


This by-law takes effect on its final passing.

### 4. **EXPIRATION**

This by-law shall expire on 30 June 2005.

**TOWNSHIP OF PRINCE  
WASTE MANAGEMENT POLICIES AND PROCEDURES**

**SECTION:** Waste Collection  
**SUBJECT** Tags for Excess Garbage  
**DATE:** 10 February 2004

**POLICY:** It is the policy of the Township of Prince to reduce refuse sent to the landfill, thereby reducing both short and long term costs, both fiscally and environmentally

By-law 2004-3 provides for a limitation on garbage containers placed for curb-side pick up. The By-law also provides for "tagging" of excess garbage

**PROCEDURE:**

- 1.0 Communal Locations**  
Property owners who ordinarily place garbage for pick up at a communal location shall advise the municipal office. Once confirmed, tags shall be provided on a monthly basis upon request. Communal tags shall be of a different colour than tags for which a fee is paid.
- 1.1 Philanthropic Collection**  
Where excess garbage is generated by community clean ups of roads and ditches by private citizens, the citizen in question shall contact the municipal office for free tags for this refuse; alternatively, the bags shall be brought to the Community Centre for disposal with municipal refuse.
- 1.2 Home Based Businesses**  
Home based businesses which pay commercial taxes in addition to residential taxes shall be granted additional tags at no charge. Home based businesses which are not paying commercial tax will be required to comply with residential garbage limitations.
- 1.3 Multi Family Properties**  
Multi-family properties which are in conformity with the zoning by-law (or legal non-conforming) and are reflected as such on the tax roll be provided with extra tags at no charge.
