**BY-LAW 2004-18**


STREETS: A by-law to establish as a street and assume for public use part of a 66 foot road in the Prince Lake Subdivision, (known as Prince Road and properly known as Prince Lake Road)

THE COUNCIL of the Corporation of the Township of Prince, pursuant to the Municipal Act, 2001 and amendments thereto ENACTS as follows:

1. **STREET ESTABLISHED AND ASSUMED**  
The street or part of the street more particularly described in Schedule "A" to this by-law is hereby established as a public street and is hereby assumed for public use.
2. **SCHEDULE "A"**  
Schedule "A" forms part of this by-law
3. **BY-LAW 99-10**  
By-law 99-10 is amended by deleting therefrom any reference to Part 2, Plan 1R-9552
3. **EFFECTIVE DATE**  
This by-law takes effect on the day of its final passing.
