#### CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PRINCE

#### **BY-LAW 2007-6**

**TRAFFIC:** A by-law to provide load limits on specified bridges.

**THE COUNCIL** of the Corporation of the Township of Prince, pursuant Section 123(2) of the *Highway Traffic Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. H. 8 as amended,

**ENACTS** as follows:

### 1. <u>MAXIMUM WEIGHT OF VEHICLES ON BRIDGES</u>

When properly worded signs have been erected and are on display, no person shall drive, move or operate any vehicle or any combination of vehicles over any bridge set out in Column 1 of Schedule "A" to this by-law, if the gross weight of such vehicle or combination of vehicles, including the load carried on such vehicle or on such combination of vehicles, is greater than the weight set out opposite such bridge in Column 2 of said Schedule "A".

### 2. EXCEPTION FOR EMERGENCY VEHICLES

When responding to an emergency, *Emergency Vehicles*, as defined by the *Highway Traffic Act*, are exempt from the weight restrictions in Schedule "A" to this by-law. *Emergency Vehicles* shall slow to no more than 30 km/h when crossing the bridges listed in Schedule "A".

#### 3. <u>PENALTY</u>

Any person who contravenes Section 1 of this by-law is liable, upon conviction, to a penalty provided therefore by the *Highway Traffic Act*.

#### 4. SCHEDULE "A"

Schedule "A" attached hereto forms part of this by-law.

# 5. <u>EFFECTIVE DATE</u>

This by-law shall take effect on the day of its final passing.

BRIDGE	MAXIMUM GROSS WEIGHT
Town Line Road, 1.3 km south of Second Line over Little Carp River	10 Tonnes
Base Line, 0.6 km west of Town Line Road	10 Tonnes
Base Line, 0.8 km west of Town Line over the Big Carp River	10 Tonnes
Town Line Road, 0.8 km south of Second Line over the Little Carp River	16 Tonnes
Gagnon Road, 0.73 km south of Second Line over the Big Carp River	16 Tonnes
