RE: 1964 Road Estimates By-law

Enclosed are four copies of By-law Form MR-16 and three copies of supporting Road Programme MR-18 for use when submitting estimates of 1964 normal road expenditures for which your township will claim subsidy under The Highway Improvement Act.

In order that the expenditures for this district may be kept within the amounts allocated to it, it is necessary to advise you that the maximum estimates that may be approved for your township for normal expenditures shall not exceed

\$ --- for Construction and \$5,000. for Maintenance.

When preparing the by-law and supporting road programme be careful to see that the various sub-totals on programme agree with the amounts entered in the by-law. All totals should be rounded to the nearest hundred dollars.

Please pay attention to the footnote on the Road Programme re Distribution of Overhead, Construction and Maintenance.

Three copies of the completed by-law and two copies of the programme must be forwarded to the undersigned not later than March 31st, 1964.

A supplementary by-law and programme for special capital works of a permanent, non-recurrent nature will be accepted for consideration later, if required, but it is necessary to ask that they be submitted not later than July 31st, 1964.

BY-LAW NO. 553

A BY-LAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE 1964 EXPENDITURES ON ROADS IN THE
TOWNSHIP OF Princeton IN THE COUNTY OF Algonia
DISTRICT

WHEREAS The Highway Improvement Act requires that the total expenditure on roads be provided for annually by by-law and that the by-law be submitted to the Minister of Highways for approval.

THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the said Township enacts as follows:

(1) The sum of \$ 5,000 is hereby estimated as the expenditure upon the construction and maintenance of the roads and bridges under its jurisdiction during the year 1964 as follows:

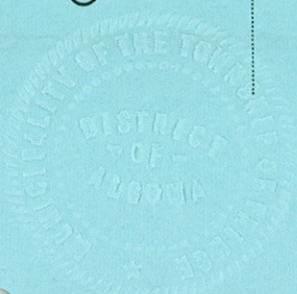
(2) The said monies shall be expended under the supervision of the duly appointed township road superintendent and on work performed in accordance with The Highway Improvement Act.

(3) The clerk shall transmit duplicate copies of this by-law to the district office of the Municipal Roads Branch, Department of Highways, Ontario not later than March 31st of the said year.

(4) The approval of the Ontario Municipal Board shall be obtained before any expenditure is authorized or work commenced which will be financed by the issue of debentures or monies raised in a subsequent year.
