BY LAW 371

A BY LAW TO ESTABLISH A DISTRICT WELFARE
ADMINISTRATION BOARD IN ACCORDANCE WITH
THE DISTRICT WELFARE ADMINISTRATION BOARDS
ACT, 1962-63

WHEREAS subsection 1 of section 3 of The District Welfare Administration
Boards Act, 1962-63, Statutes of Ontario, 1962-63, Chapter 37, provides as
follows:

"A district welfare administration board shall be
established and maintained for a district by all the
municipalities in the district when a by-law authorizing
the establishment of the board has been passed by a
majority of the municipalities in the district"

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Township
of Toronto deems it advisable to establish a district
welfare administration board pursuant to the provisions of the said Act,

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF
the Township of Toronto

THAT a District Welfare Administration Board be established and maintained for
the territorial district of Toronto, to provide and administer welfare
services in all municipalities in the said district in accordance with the
provisions of the said Act.

Read a first and second time this 21 day of January 1966.

Read a third time and finally passed this 27 day of January 1966.
