

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PRINCE

BY-LAW NO. 377

WHEREAS it has been made to appear that many persons have created a nuisance by depositing and leaving upon the highways of the Municipal Township of Prince, dirt, filth, glass, handbills, paper, tin cans and other rubbish and refuse;

AND WHEREAS by the Municipal Act of the Province of Ontario, R.S.O., 1960, Ch. 249, Section 476, Subsection 4, authority is granted to Councils of Municipalities to pass by-laws prohibiting the throwing, placing and depositing on any highway or bridge all dirt, filth, glass, handbills, paper or other rubbish or refuse or the carcass of any animal.

NOW THEREFORE The Township of Prince

ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. No person shall throw, place or deposit on any highway or bridge within the limits of the Municipal Township of Prince, any dirt, filth, glass, handbills, paper or other rubbish, refuse or the carcass of any animal.
2. Every person who contravenes the terms of this by-law shall be guilty of an offence and shall, upon conviction thereof before a police Magistrate or Justice of the peace, be liable to a penalty not exceeding \$300.00 for such offence, together with the costs of prosecution, and, in default of payment, such offender may be committed to the common jail for a period not exceeding six months unless the penalty and costs be sooner paid.
3. All By-laws of the Township of Prince in any way relating to the matter covered by this By-law is hereby repealed.
