

BYLAW NUMBER 381

OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PRINCE

Being a bylaw to legalize the holding of a nomination meeting and Election in and for the Township of Prince to be held in 1967 for the years 1968 and 1969

The Municipal Council of The Township of Prince, in the District of Algoma enacts as follows:

That a nomination meeting for the purpose of nominating a Reeve, Council Members and Public School Trustees for the said Township for the years 1968 and 1969 shall be held in the Township Office, R. R. #1, Second Line, Prince, on the 22nd day of November, 1967 at the hour of 8:00 to 9:00 o'clock in the afternoon. If more candidates are proposed for any particular office than required to be elected, an election will be held on Monday, December 4, 1967. The Poll will be held at the Township Office, R. R. #1, Second Line.

The hours for voting shall be from 10:00 a.m. to 8 p.m.
