

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PRINCE

BY-LAW NO. 387

A By-law to prohibit the erection of signs or other advertising devices on buildings, or vacant lots or on any land on highway within the Township of Prince

The Council of the Corporation of the Township of Prince, pursuant to paragraph 122 of Subsection 1 of Section 379 of The Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1960, Chapter 249,

ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. No person shall erect a sign or other advertising device on a building, vacant lot, or any land abutting on any highways or public roads or parts of highways in the Township of Prince. For the purposes of this by-law, any lands within five hundred feet (500') shall be deemed to be abutting on the highway.
2. Every person who contravenes this by-law shall upon conviction thereof, forfeit and pay at the discretion of the convicting Magistrate, a penalty of not more than three hundred (\$300.00) dollars, exclusive of costs.
3. This by-law comes into force on the day of its final passing.

READ a first, second and third time, and finally passed in open Council this 5th day of March 1968.
