

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PRINCE

BY-LAW NO. 396

REGULATIONS: A by-law to regulate horses on streets.

THE COUNCIL of the Corporation of the Township of Prince, pursuant to paragraphs 1, 1a, 4 and 101 of subsection 1 of section 379 and subsections 51 and 52 of Section 377 of The Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1960, chapter 249 and amendments thereto, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1.

DEFINITION

In this by-law "street" includes a common and public highway and a bridge forming part of a highway on, over or across which a highway or street passes.

2.

GENERAL REGULATIONS - ALL LANDS

In the Township of Prince no person shall

- (1) lead, ride or drive a horse upon any sidewalk or footpath or any place not proper therefor;
- (2) permit a horse owned by him or in his custody to run at large;
- (3) permit a horse owned by him or in his custody to trespass upon the property of any other person.

3.

REGULATIONS - HORSES ON STREETS

On a street in the Township of Prince no person shall

- (1) ride or drive any horse at an immoderate or dangerous rate of speed;
- (2) drive, ride or lead a horse except such horse shall be under his control;
- (3) break-in a horse, provided however that this subsection shall not prevent a horse otherwise broken-in being trained to behave properly with respect to vehicular and other traffic on a street;
- (4) permit his horse, wagon, carriage, sleigh or other vehicle to stand unless such horse shall be securely tied, either to a post or attached to a suitable weight, but in so doing no person shall in any way obstruct the free use of any sidewalk or street crossing;
- (5) ride any horse unless such person is sitting astride such horse;
- (6) ride a horse unless such person shall be competent so to do;
- (7) ride any horse other than as close to the right hand side of such street, having regard to the direction of travel, as is reasonably practicable in the circumstances;
- (8) permit a horse owned by him or in his custody to be used by any person who is not competent so to do;
- (9) no person shall ride before sun rise and after sun set.

4. RIDING ABREAST - PARADES

- (1) Not more than two horses shall be ridden abreast on any street in the Township of Prince.
- (2) Subsection 1 shall not apply to the riding of horses in a parade for which a permit has been obtained from the By-Law Enforcement Official.

5. PENALTY

Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this by-law is liable upon summary conviction therefor to a penalty not exceeding \$300 exclusive of costs.

6. EFFECT

This by-law takes effect on the day of its final passing.
