

BY-LAW No. 399

A BY-LAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE 19 68 EXPENDITURES ON ROADS IN THE
TOWNSHIP OF PRINCE IN THE COUNTY OF ALGOMA
DISTRICT

WHEREAS The Highway Improvement Act requires that the total expenditure on roads be provided for annually by by-law and that the by-law be submitted to the Minister of Highways for approval.

THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the said Township enacts as follows:

(1) The sum of \$ 600.00 is hereby estimated as the expenditure upon the construction and maintenance of the roads and bridges under its jurisdiction during the year 19 68 as follows:

(2) The said monies shall be expended under the supervision of the duly appointed township road superintendent and on work performed in accordance with The Highway Improvement Act.

(3) The clerk shall transmit **Triplicate** copies of this by-law to the district office of the Department of Highways, Ontario, not later than March 31st of the said year.

(4) The approval of the Ontario Municipal Board shall be obtained before any expenditure is authorized or work commenced which will be financed by the issue of debentures or monies raised in a subsequent year.

Please advise your Council that the Honourable George E. Gomme, Minister of Highways, has been pleased to approve By-law Number 399 of your Municipality in the amount of \$ 250.00

This approval was possible only because there was a small surplus in the 1968-69 subsidy vote after previous subsidy commitments had been satisfied.

There is little likelihood that a similar surplus will exist in the current fiscal year. Your Council would be well-advised to avoid making any expenditure commitments on which it expects subsidy before receiving approval of the related expenditure by-law.
